

SOUTH ISLAND GYPSY COB SHOW

This is a qualifying show for the Gypsy Cob Section at Horse of the Year 2019

Sunday 16nd December 2018 Melton Park, 4 Melton Park Lane, West Melton

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - Entries close 3rd December 2018 (SI)

- This show is for Pure or Partbred Gypsy Cobs only. Horses MUST be registered & the owner a financial member of the New Zealand Gypsy Cob Association Incorporated at close of entries
- 2. Back numbers are to be supplied by the competitor. NO back numbers available on the day
- Age of horse is recognised as 1st August. Age of Rider/Handler as of date of the show
- 4. Height Certificates are not required.
- ALL riders must wear protective headgear, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at two or more points at all times while riding.
- 6. ALL Colts/Stallions 12 months & over MUST be shown in a bridle & bit.

To wear 2 official 'S" identification badges, one attached to each side of their bridle/halter at all times, with the exception of foals

Handlers & Riders must also wear two RAS official armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring

An attendant 17 years or over in addition to the handler/rider to remain on standby at all times

Pony Stallions must be ridden by riders 14 years & over. Stallions over 148cm must be led or ridden by a rider 17 years of age or older

No colts/stallions are to be left unattended or tied to floats/trucks at anytime while on the show grounds

An official can order any stallion/colt considered out of control or to be causing undue disquiet to other horses from the ring without recourse from the stallion/colt's owner/exhibitor/competitor

Colts/stallions will be eliminated with no refund given if the above rules are not adhered

7. Novice ridden has not had more than 5 wins in a ridden gypsy cob conformation class. **Snaffle bits only**. Novices are eligible to enter Open classes

- **8.** Protests must be accompanied by a \$50 deposit, refundable if the protest is sustained & submitted no later than half an hour after the incident that gave rise to the protest.
- 9. No Dogs permitted on the grounds, failure to comply will result in disqualification with no refund.
- 10. The NZGCA Committee reserves the right to alter/delete the programme as they see fit.
- **11.** Any competitor or spectator found mistreating a horse, competing a horse deemed to be lame by the judge, arguing/fighting or being abusive to other competitors, judges or officials will be eliminated with no refund & asked to leave the grounds immediately. This includes ringside behaviour.
- 12. In the event of sickness or injury, 75% of total entry fees will be refunded if a qualified Veterinarian or Doctors certificate ONLY is produced to the Show Secretary within 5 working days of the competition. No other refunds will be made.
- 13. NZGCA accepts no responsibility for injury, loss or damage to Property, Horse, Handler/Rider or Spectator
- **14.** Any Lapels, Badges, Rugs or similar that identify <u>previous awards won</u> are banned from being worn on the rider/handler or horse/pony in or near the ring.
- 15. A very limited number of yards and boxes are available for the day at the SI Show, these will be issued in order of mares & foals then youngstock, and then others if available. You will be advised at close of entries if a box/yard is allocated to you. The National Equestrian Centre at McLeans Island is a 10 minute drive from Melton Park and has ample stabling, yarding and camping facilities. Bookings can be made directly with them. ALL manure/hay must be picked up and placed in designated area from boxes, yards and around floats, etc.

Judged from 1st placegetters in classes 15 & 17. 2nd placegetters to standby

- 20. Best Lead Rein Combination Pure or Partbred
- 21. Best First Ridden Combination Pure or Partbred (no cantering)

(Classes 20 & 21 are for riders under 12, combinations can only enter one class)

HANDY COB CLASSES – The Handy Cob course will be open from 10.30am to 1pm. Make your way over to the Handy Cob course and do this when it suits you in this time frame.

The Handy Cob course will be a made up of a variety of off road obstacles and will be judged on style, fluidity and the working partnership between horse and rider/handler as a team.

- 22. Adult Inhand Handy Gypsy Cob
- 23. Adult Ridden Handy Gypsy Cob
- 24. Youth Inhand Handy Gypsy Cob (Handler 16 & under)
- 25. Youth Ridden Gypsy Cob (Rider 16 & under)

HUNTER JUMPING - to follow straight on after the ridden classes.

- 26. Hunter jumping (Judged on Style) 50cm max
- 27. Hunter jumping (Judged on Style) 75cm max

HARNESS SECTION 1.30pm

28: Best Harness Purebred or Partbred Gypsy Cob – this class will be judged over a course which will combine dressage, scurry, obstacles and presentation.

At the completion of the harness section there will be the prizegiving for the Handy Cob Classes, Hunter Jumping and Harness classes.

Champion and Reserve Champion Versatility Pure or Partbred Gypsy Cob - to be awarded to the highest scoring Gypsy Cob throughout the day. Points to be awarded 5 for 1st, 4 for 2nd, 3 for 3rd, 2 for 4th and 1 for 5th, taken from all classes.
